4. Ground and Clubhouse Development

We are currently progressing plans to re-build our current facilities.

The plans are to provide the following facilities:

- > Brand new clubhouse and car parking
- > New changing facilities
- > Rubber crumb/new generation pitch
- > New floodlights
- > Function room to include indoor cricket nets
- > New drainage
- > Increase pitch numbers

The objective is to create one of the best sporting facilities in Leicestershire which will be open to all club members and the local community. As part of this plan we are aiming to have the facility open and being used, seven days a week.

The Meadows Sports Association is currently in talks with the Council, local Architects, County FA and Funding Providers

We would hope to have the facilities open before 2012 (just in time to fine tune your skills for the Olympics!)
